



## **DOG PARK of Lower Paxton**

### **BECOME A PUBLICLY RECOGNIZED SPONSOR OF THE LOWER PAXTON DOG PARK**

Proposed to open on Memorial Day Weekend in 2009, the Lower Paxton Dog Park, situated on one acre of ground in Kohl Park off Union Deposit Road, will become a community gathering place for dog owners. The park will be open to all people and canines in the Greater Harrisburg area.

#### **We see the development of the dog park as a model of public-private cooperation:**

- Lower Paxton Township has donated land and the ongoing park maintenance.
- Over 700 residents have signed a dog park petition and are being approached for start-up donations.
- The PA Conservation Corps has agreed to erect the fencing and build the wooden benches and structures at no cost.
- State Representative Ron Marsico is seeking a \$10,000 Department of Community and Economic Development grant to help purchase fencing, lumber and trees.
- Members of the community have agreed to volunteer their time to plant trees, monitor the park and further develop the park amenities.

Here's where you come in. We estimate the park start-up costs to be \$17,000-\$20,000 with ongoing costs being \$2,000-\$3,000/year. So, we need businesses in our community to help offset the costs with varying levels of tax deductible sponsorship.

**Here's what you receive as a sponsor.** At the entrance to the dog park, there will be a sponsor board listing platinum, gold, silver and bronze sponsors' names and logos. Platinum sponsors will receive the largest signage, with gold, silver and bronze sponsors receiving smaller images. Sponsors will also be listed on our website.

**Thousands of dog owners throughout Greater Harrisburg will see your name and logo on a regular basis. They will know that your company supports their canine friends.**

The following are the levels of sponsorship:

Platinum	\$5,000 and up
Gold	\$2,500 and up
Silver	\$1,000 and up
Bronze	\$ 500 and up

Businesses donating \$100-\$499 will receive recognition on the park sponsor board.
